Hyperbole

An exaggerated statement.

two things that uses






🤼 as quiet as a mouse



Metaphors

A comparison in which one thing



is said to be another.





She is a walking dictionary.



Personification

Giving human qualities to animals or objects.

Example:

The stars winked at me.





Alliteration

Alliteration is the <u>repetition</u> of initial sounds in neighboring words.



Allie ate apples all afternoon.

Idioms





Idioms are phrases which people use in everyday language which do not make sense literally, but we understand what they mean.
